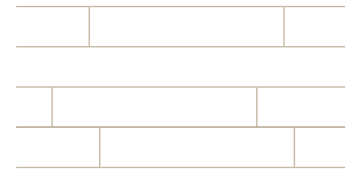

Douglas – Random lengths

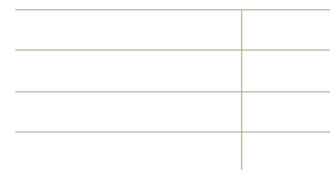
Planks in random lengths are delivered in available lengths. This makes for a fluid transition from one room to the next and a coherent expression that is perfect for many projects. Each plank is made as long as possible, which makes it possible to use a very high proportion of the raw wood.

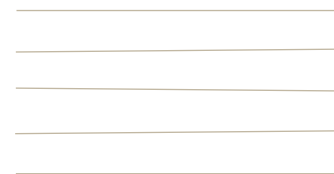

Douglas - Pattern

Pattern is an option where large planks are laid in familiar historical patterns. A modern solution with respect for history, which takes on a contemporary and exclusive appearance due to the proportions.

For planks wider than 300 mm, make sure to allow for the fact that the planks have to be laid with a 2 mm gap in accordance with Dinesen's additional "Pattern" instructions.

Herringbone

Solid planks laid in a herringbone pattern is a timeless solution. Choosing large dimensions in the individual planks takes the classic pattern to new heights with an impressive expression and an elegant look.



Chevron

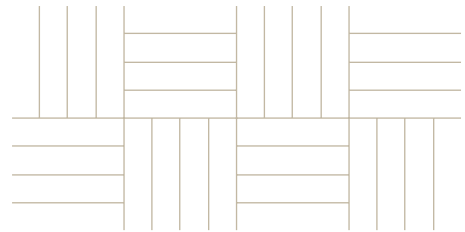
A distinctive graphic pattern that takes on even more character in large plank dimensions. Finishing the planks in the same color creates a beautiful uniform expression.



A Chevron floor is made from planks in full lengths adapted to the individual rooms to ensure the best possible solution. The planks are chamfered on site as part of the assembly to ensure sufficient precision. Overall, the material consumption is increased for a Chevron floor compared to other pattern floors due to the consumption partly in connection with the individual adaption and secondarily in connection with the geometry of each room, which is why the m2 prices in this price list cannot be used without calculating the consumption first. Based on a floor plan, our employees are happy to evaluate and calculate a Chevron floor for your particular project.

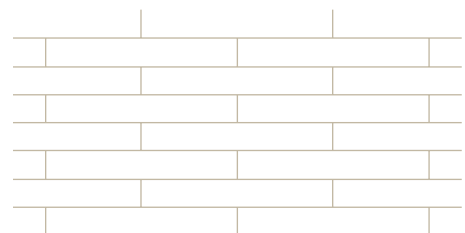
Mosaic
